A summary of these meetings is included in the table below and designated by an \*.

\*CUE 2017 Conference: This conference will provide two keynotes and dozens of sessions with hands-on activities led by Google Certified Teachers and Google Apps Certified Trainers, including instructional strategies with ties to advance student achievement at all levels of education and to address the use of Education Technology in instruction, administration, curriculum and management.
